

Dear Tracy Symonds

I have seen a copy of your 25 November 2016 letter to my landlord Mr John Layte.

I think it is a good idea if I correct the mistakes you have made regarding the water supply to the Annexe. The stop tap at Tailings End is not turned off. It has been turned on for over a year so that Mr Shannon can take readings and I was at the meeting when John gave him a key. Mr Layte has not prevented me from using your water the truth of the matter is I do not trust its quality since filthy water came through my tap sometime last summer. I am concerned that water from the cattle troughs on Goon Farm has been getting into my water for years and is the reason I seemed to suffer from diarrhoea which stopped as soon as I stopped using your water for drinking and cooking. I have asked John to write to you to get the water tested at my home and confirm that all the cattle troughs in the area are up to your normal standard. He tells me he has done this but you have not replied. I have not seen you test the water here but I may have been out so if you have tested it here please let me know the results. John tells me he has looked at two of the cattle troughs on Goon Farm in the last few days but they are still not up to standard. Finally my Father does not reside here at the Annexe he lives in Trispen and has been bringing me drinking water usually three times a week for about 18 months and I also buy drinking water from the supermarket. My father has been to see my MP Sarah Newton regarding this matter.
