Attached is an aerial view of the known pipes on and around Goon Farm. Obviously there are other unknown pipes on Goon Farm land connected to the same supply as ourselves so we do not see that the so called leak is entirely our responsibility.

Since my last phone call with Matt Nicks we have discovered a second trough on Goon Farm land connected to the supply with the alleged leak. We have not tested any others.

We turned off the stop tap at Tailings End at 11:50 this morning (meter reading 138,021 ltr).

The two troughs on Goon Farm are thus now turned off (as we are!).

Both Mevin Chalis and David Lanyon's tenant farmer report that their supply has also stopped.

We will be able to survive for at least a week without mains water but the supply may need to be turned on for the sake of the animals on the two smallholdings. Please give this matter your urgent attention.
